

RELAXING THAILAND (5 NIGHTS/ 6 DAYS)

Chiang Mai, Thailand's major Northern Province and second city is one of the country's most fascinating destinations. Just one hour from Bangkok, Thailand's northern capital, surrounded by majestic mountains that stretch across into Laos, China and Burma, offers heritage, hill-tribes, inspiring scenery and a unique cultural experience. Koh Samui is unique among Thailand's islands in maintaining a broad appeal to everyone. This helps to give the distinctive relaxed atmosphere that sets it apart.

Day 1: ARRIVE CHIANG MAI

Welcome to Chiang Mai – The city on the Ping river. On arrival at the Chiang Mai Airport, you will be transferred to your hotel. While the rest of your day is free at leisure. Chiangmai is a city of distinct beauty that has its own cultural heritage. Known also as the "ROSE OF THE NORTH". Along with its numerous ancient temples and building, Chiang Mai is also famous for its handicrafts. Nature has made it stand out, thanks to the majestic mountains and valleys and its beautiful scenery: hills, mountain streams, lakes, field, waterfalls, caves, hill tribe villages, orchid, butterfly farms, elephant camps & trekking tours and river rafting expeditions. Over night stay at the Hotel.

Day 2: CHIANG MAI

After breakfast, proceeds for a half day City Tour of Chiang Mai. Sightseeing in Chiang Mai city is like stepping into a living museum where ancient pagodas pop up around every corner, antique houses line quaint lanes, and a timeless old town is soaked in historic character. Visit 4 Different Temples as Wat Phra Singh, Wat Chedi Luang, Wat Chiang Man and Wat Suan Dok then we will make a city sightseeing tour to see a daily life of Northern peoples. This tour is visit to the ancient Chiang Mai's City walls to visit the beautiful temples of Wat Chedi Luang and the Wat Phar Singha (founded 1345AD), to view a collection of fine building including its old library. Wat Chiang Mai is another temple, which houses the sacred Buddha image and the beautiful chedi surrounded by stone elephant heads, A stop is made at Wat Suan Dok. Which contains ash of Chiang Mai's Royal Family, before touring the city and return to your hotel. Over night stay at Chiang Mai Hotel.

Day 3: ARRIVE SAMUI

After breakfast, proceeds for a transfer to the airport for flight to Samui and then transfer to your chosen hotel at Samui. The airport on Koh Samui is often considered as one of the most beautiful and exotic airports in the world. **Koh Samui** (เกาะสมุย in Thai language) is the island of thousands of coconut trees. There is a 55 kilometer long ring road on the island which makes it convenient to travel from beach to beach. Welcome to Samui –Thailand's second largest. On arrival at the Samui Airport, you will be transferred to your hotel. Then you will proceed for a half day island tour. You will visit The Temple of Big Budha or Wat Phra Yai, stop at the bizarre formation of Grandmother and Grandfather (Hin – Ta – Hin Yai) in Lamai and watch the popular monkeys at work show. Further stops will be made along the way at various view points and at Na- Muang Waterfall. End your day at Nathon town for some shopping. Over night stay at the Hotel.

Day 4: KOH SAMUI – PHUKET

After breakfast, proceeds for a transfer to the airport for flight to Phuket and then transfer to your chosen hotel at Phuket. Day at leisure. In the evening proceed to Phuket Fantasea Show with dinner. Phuket Fantasea is culture night time entertainment theme park on the Kamala Beach. The park features numerous attractions and adventure into Thailand's ancient culture and realm of myths. Charming and beautiful classical dances from Thailand's various regions play a prominent part in the variety of shows presented. Over night stay at Phuket Hotel.

Day 5: PHUKET

Morning breakfast at the hotel, then proceed for a half day city tour of Phuket, Take in Phuket Island's natural beauty as you are driven along beach roads through Patong, Karon, Kata and Rawai. Visit the 'Three Beaches' viewpoint where you can take in a great vista of the beautiful bays of Kata Noi, Kata, Karon and Kho Pu Island, at one of the island's best scenic spots. This tour gives an insight into the highlights of the 'Pearl of the Andaman'. It also includes a leisurely drive around Phuket Town to view the Sino-Portuguese style buildings. Other attractions visited are Wang Thalung Lapidary gem factory, Mookda Herbal Centre, Wat Chalong, Phuket's most beautiful and renowned monastery, the Sea Gypsy Village at Rawai Beach, a Cashew Nut Factory where you may sample the culinary delights on offer and the famous sunset viewpoint at Promthep Cape one of the most beautiful panoramas on the island. Over night stay at the Hotel.

Day 6: DEPARTURE FROM PHUKET

Morning breakfast at Hotel. Shopping is a pleasure in Phuket, not only because of the variety of things to buy but also because there are numerous air-conditioned, modern shopping centers as well as the bargain hunter's plethora of street vendors. Depending on your frame of mind and budget, you can both wheel and deal in the streets or casually stroll through the air-conditioned shopping centers. It's time to have some shop until you transfer to the airport for flight back to India with the beautiful memories.
