

MOUNT THE GREAT WALL- BEIJING- 04 NIGHTS / 05 DAYS

Beijing, the heart of China, is always the first choice of travelers who are willing to know a time-honored and developed city of China. It has been the political, economic and cultural center of China for over 800 years from the Yuan Dynasty. The numerous royal buildings with long history endow Beijing with incomparable charm, not only the 'Nation's Best' but also the 'World's Best'.

Day 1: Welcome to the Marble City

Formerly known in English as Peking, Beijing is the capital of the People's Republic of China. Beijing borders Hebei Province to its three sides - the north, west and south. To the southeast it borders Tianjin Municipality.

Beijing is one of the most visited cities in the and home to some of the country's most outstanding sights and temples. A buzzing city where there is always plenty of action, during your trip to Beijing you can expect to visit the Forbidden City, the Great Wall of China, the Temple of Heaven Park and much more besides, whilst shopping and eating to your heart's content. Day 2: Great Wall Excursion

Embark on your day excursion to the Great wall. The Great Wall of China, one of the greatest wonders of the world, was listed as a World Heritage by UNESCO in 1987. Just like a gigantic dragon, the Great Wall winds up and down across deserts, grasslands, mountains and plateaus, stretching approximately 8,851.8 kilometres (5,500 miles) from east to west of China. With a history of more than 2000 years, some of the sections are now in ruins or have disappeared. However, it is still one of the most appealing attractions all around the world owing to its architectural grandeur and historical significance. The highlight of your stay in this ancient capital is a visit to the Great Wall of Ju Yong Guan, and Jade Factory. Later departs for the iconic Beijing 2008 Olympic Center, the Bird's Nest & Water Cube. Lunch at a local restaurant. Dinner at nearby restaurant. Overnight at the hotel.

Day3.Tiananmen Square, Forbidden City& Cabaret Show with Dinner

After breakfast, you will first visit the historic Tiananmen Square, the largest city square in the world, followed by the magnificent Forbidden City, which is the largest palace structure in the world and the place where China's emperors ruled for over 600 years. In Evening Cabaret Show with Dinner. This is one entertainment that must not be missed by the young and old on a visit to Beijing. Day 4: Temple Of Heaven, Summer Palace & Wangfujing Shopping Street

After breakfast, you will first visit The Temple Of Heaven. Literally the Altar of Heaven is a complex of Taoist buildings situated in the southeastern part of central Beijing. The temple complex was constructed from 1406 to 1420 during the reign of the Yongle Emperor, who was also responsible for the construction of the Forbidden City in Beijing. The complex was extended and renamed *Temple of Heaven* during the reign of the Jiajing Emperor in the 16th century. The Jiajing Emperor also built three other prominent temples in Beijing, the Temple of Sun in the east , the Temple of Earth in the north , and the Temple of Moon in the west.The Temple of Heaven was renovated in the 18th century under the Qianlong Emperor. Due to the deterioration of state budget, this became the last large-scale

renovation of the temple complex in the imperial time.Later proceed for Summer Palace, a Imperial Garden in Beijing. The Summer Palace in Beijing – first built in 1750, largely destroyed in the war of 1860 and restored on its original foundations in 1886 – is a masterpiece of Chinese landscape garden design. The natural landscape of hills and open water is combined with artificial features such as pavilions, halls, palaces, temples and bridges to form a harmonious ensemble of outstanding aesthetic value.After visting Summer Palace you will be headed towards Wangfujing Street the famous shopping street in Beijing.This street is famous for fashinable & trendy shopping. Overnight at the Hotel.

Day 5: Depart India

After breakfast you will be transferred to the Airport for your departure flight back home or onward destinations.
