

## **THE BEST OF THAILAND (6 NIGHTS/ 7 DAYS)**

**Bangkok, the City of Angels** is the capital city of Thailand. Bangkok is the hub for most of the commercial and economical activities of the Kingdom. At the same time, the City is very famous and appreciated by visitors for its versatility and multiple points of interests. From temples, the Grand Palace, all the way over the some of Asia's largest shopping centers and the largest outdoor market of Asia (Chatuchak), Bangkok definitely has what it takes to entertain visitors from all origins, either first time or return travelers. Whilst Taxi fares are very reasonable, most of the sightseeing can comfortably be reached by Skytrain (BTS) or Underground train (MRT). Aside of the sightseeing and shopping, Bangkok has developed into a magnet for food lovers of all origins. The same range of choice applies to the accommodation options all over town, from high end international chain hotels to family run guesthouses, demands of all travelers are met. In terms of wellness and relaxation – Bangkok has recently seen a huge development of city Spas and Wellness centers, in addition to the long established Thai massage centers.

### **Day 1 : Arrival into Phuket**

Welcome to Phuket – one of the most popular beach destination in Asia. On arrival at the Phuket Airport, you will be transferred to your hotel. Spectacular scenery, stunning tropical sunsets and warm blue sea awaits you at Asia's most popular beach destination. This fun island provides an unbeatable combination of perfect silky soft white palm-lined beaches. You are free to enjoy the day at leisure. Overnight stay at the hotel.

### **Day 2: Half day Phuket City Tour**

Morning breakfast at the hotel, then proceed for a half day city tour of Phuket, Take in Phuket Island's natural beauty as you are driven along beach roads through Patong, Karon, Kata and Rawai. ### **Day 3: Phuket – Bangkok - Pattaya**

After breakfast, check out from the hotel & transfer to the airport for flight to Bangkok. Upon arrival in Bangkok, transferred to the hotel in Pattaya. Upon arrival pamper yourself in the flower bath that has been drawn for you while enjoying light afternoon snacks. ### **Day 4: Half day Coral Island tour with lunch - Pattaya**

After Breakfast, proceed for Half day Coral Island Tour - **Ko Larn** is the best known out of a group of small islands a few miles off the coast of Pattaya. It is popular with day visitors who want to spend a day on a wide sandy beach and do some snorkeling. Sail across the sparkling aqua-blue water of the Gulf of Thailand to the Coral Island (**Ko Larn**). Here under the brilliant

tropical sun, you can relax, swim, or simply bronze yourself on the island's golden beaches. Later, return to Pattaya Bay after a delicious buffet lunch. Evening is at leisure. Overnight stay at the hotel.

#### **Day 5: Pattaya - Bangkok**

After breakfast, proceeds for a transfer to the airport for your flight to Bangkok and then transfer to your chosen hotel at Bangkok. Bangkok is today Thailand's capital and was founded in 1782 by King Rama I (named Phra Buddha Yodfa Chulaloke). It is situated on the Great Chao Phya River Delta which flows from the North down to the Gulf of Thailand. The word **Bangkok** is derived from two primitive Thai words, i.e. "Bang" meaning Village and "Kok" meaning Olive. Thus its original meaning is "Village of Olives. Rest of the day is at your leisure. Overnight stay at the hotel.

#### **Day 6: Half day city tour - Bangkok**

After your breakfast, transfer to Bang Kong & enjoy a City and Temple Tour. Visit the famous 'Wat Traimit 'or the Golden Buddha made of solid gold weighing five and a half tons, the Marble Temple or ' Wat Benchamabopit' and ' WatPo' or the Temple of the Reclining Buddha. After going through the spiritual & religious sights of Bangkok we take you to the largest GEM & Jewellery factory in Thailand for glimpse of the precious stone. Over night stay in hotel

#### **Day 7: Departure from Bangkok**

Morning Breakfast at the Hotel. Time to have some shop until you transfer to the airport for flight back to India with the beautiful memories.
